



DRAGON 100 Young Chinese Leaders Forum 2002

It was of special significance that the Year 2000, which ushered in the new millennium, was also celebrated in Chinese culture as the Year of the Dragon. To honour this once in a lifetime occurrence, the “Dragon at the Great Wall” Project was launched, which brought together 10,000 young people of Chinese origin from around the world, empowering, envisioning and encouraging them to be Leaders of Tomorrow.

To continue the legacy of the Dragon – which is felt in its energy strength and leadership, borne with the hopes and promises of a better future – beyond 2000, the Dragon Foundation was established.

The Foundation is a long-term investment, bringing together two facets of the mighty Dragon: its descendants and its leadership qualities. With its focus on youth as the driving force in the development of society, the Foundation firmly believes that these young people of Chinese origin have the potential, talent and creativity to make a significant contribution to society, no matter what their field. It is this belief that commits the Foundation to their training and facilitating their capabilities to create networks of sharing and mutual exchange, to promote Chinese culture and heritage and to be future leaders, dedicating themselves to building communities.

In this spirit, the Dragon Foundation is pleased to initiate and sponsor **DRAGON 100 Young Chinese Leaders Forum, 2002.**

DRAGON 100 – which is to be a Network of Young Chinese Leaders for Tomorrow – will annually invite 100 outstanding young people of Chinese origin from across the world, between the ages of 18 and 35, who have demonstrated leadership skills, academic prowess and a commitment to the community, to attend a Forum to discuss the relevant and pertinent global issues of the day.

Why a Forum?

It is hoped that the Forum, as a platform for meeting, sharing and discussing, will generate a synergy among the participants to work together for the betterment of their societies, forged with a spirit of innovation, enthusiasm and commitment. The Forum aims to be an annual event.

The Theme of the Forum and its Programme

The Theme of the Forum, to be held from 9-16 September 2002, is ***Opportunities in China: A Vision for a Shared Future*** and the programme will comprise a three-day Forum in Hong Kong and a four-day Study Trip to Shanghai.

In *Hong Kong*, participants will attend Plenary Sessions, addressed by world-renowned speakers on topics to include, "*Opportunities in China within the Paradigm of a Globalised Economy*", "*Embracing the Change: China's Accession to the WTO*" and "*Innovation, Participation and Cooperation: Creating a Synergy for Change*". The participants will then divide themselves into Panels to exchange their views on "A Shared Future Perspective: Seeking Opportunities in China." They will also make visits to Government and Non-government bodies; attend social activities and ceremonies and formally launch the Network of Young Chinese Leaders for Tomorrow – **DRAGON 100**. The Forum will be conducted in English.

In *Shanghai*, participants will meet with Government officials; visit major socio-economic, technological and cultural development projects; hold seminars and discussions with university students and young professionals, participate in cultural and social activities and visit sites of scenic and historic beauty.

Who will make up the Delegation?

60 outstanding young leaders from Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan and Mainland China will make up the delegation, along with 40 other ethnically Chinese youth leaders from around the world.

What are the eligibility criteria?

Apart from being of Chinese origin, the candidates must be between the ages of 18 and 35. They need to be nominated by universities, educational institutions, organisations and/or corporations.

How will candidates be selected?

The selection procedure will be to invite local and overseas organisations and institutions to nominate outstanding ethnic Chinese young people with demonstrated skills of leadership to participate. A Selection Panel, consisting of notable scholars and professionals, as well as the Directors of the Dragon Foundation, will conduct the selection.

The Panel will look for candidates who are either scholastically outstanding and are award recipients or who are outstanding in their places of work; who have shown themselves to be exceptional talents in non-academic areas, such as sports, arts, music or general creativity and who have consistently been involved in extra curricular activities and/or community service.

What are the fees?

The organiser is very pleased to be able to sponsor the delegates to cover the cost of the Programme, including return tickets to their home base, airfares and ground transportation between Hong Kong and Shanghai, travel and medical insurance, as well as all meals and accommodation as stated in the final itinerary. Those who are selected will be expected to pay visa fees and all out of pocket expenses.

What is the Nomination Procedure?

Institutions and organisations should return a completed Nomination Form, together with copies of documentary evidence, wherever appropriate, as well as the signed consent of the nominee, to:

The closing date for nominations is 7 June, 2002. All nominations will be considered by the Selection Panel, whose decisions are final. All nominees will be informed of the results by mid June 2002, with the successful nominees being sent a letter of invitation to attend the **DRAGON 100 Young Chinese Leaders Forum, 2002**.

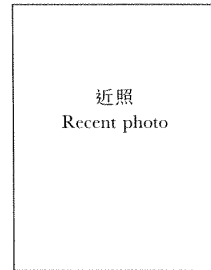
