Special Appointment before Probate Master

To speed up the process of application for Grant, commencing from November 2003, on the first Saturday morning of each month, the Probate Master will be prepared to hear representations from the practitioners regarding requisitions:

- (a) which have been left outstanding for more than four months and
- (b) (i) the applicants have special difficulties in complying with or
(ii) the solicitors consider that they could or ought to be resolved expeditiously.

The solicitor may make an appointment with the Probate Registry by a letter of request together with written submissions and authorities.

This arrangement will be reviewed from time to time and does not affect the existing practice of making request to see the Probate Master in appropriate cases.
